Toddler (15 Months - 35 Months)

1 pair of simple indoor shoes to leave at school (Light weight, easy on and off - **NO** croc style shoes please)

3 complete outfits (shirt, pants, socks, and underclothing) label all items with the child's name

- 1 package of baby wipes
- 1 small backpack
- 6 wallet sized pictures of your child
- 1 family photo (4x6)
- 1 wet clothes bag medium size
- 1 11x12 inch poster board
- 1 (1/2 inch) binder with the view window on it (Please write your child's name on the paper inside the cover not on the plastic)

Primary 3-6 Year Old

1 pair of slippers or indoor shoes - no big head or furry characters please - soles should be non-skid (no croc style shoes) - and slippers should go around the ankle (no open heels)

Full Day Students need a lunch box and thermos for hot meals (soup, macaroni and cheese, etc.) We suggest a lunch box with small containers inside

One pair of rubber pull-on boots to be left at school (full day students only)

During the first week of school your family will be assigned a few other items to bring in as a community classroom supply

Elementary Student Supply List

First grade:

- 1 box of white chalk for using on the chalkboard NO Sidewalk chalk size
- * one (2 inch) 3 ring binder (view binder) with a cover insert **DO NOT** write directly on the plastic binder write your child's name on the paper inside the front cover of the binder

Fourth, Fifth, and Sixth Grade:

- *one (2 inch) 3 ring view binder with a cover insert and
- *one (1 1/2 inch) binder with 5 or more dividers (can bring back the one from last year, if applicable)
- 1 composition notebook (any cover)
- 2 two-pocket folders
- 1 8.5" playground ball
- 1 pair of large scissors
- \$2 that can be used to purchase the right combination of extra creek clothing we need
